

We invite Jane's Walk participants to join us in exploring the lower reaches of Kelly's Brook and Rennies River. We will draw comparisons between the largely culverted Kelly's Brook, and a stretch of Rennies River that was never buried, but instead had trail infrastructure added to improve public access and enjoyment. The theme of our discussion will focus around the benefits of making Kelly's Brook an open, accessible waterway, available for public enjoyment, just like Rennies River. The talk will examine daylighting urban rivers as a public good, and as a form of respecting their ecological integrity.
